

## Getting prescriptions filled

- 1** Using the list in the right column, select a pharmacy near you.
- 2** Take your *Prescription services identification card* (blue tear-off card) with you to the pharmacy.
- 3** Show your card to the pharmacist when you get your prescription filled.

### You don't pay anything

By using your *Prescription services identification card*, you will not have to pay up front for the prescriptions you need to treat your work injury, and you will not have to submit any paperwork for reimbursement.

Instead, the pharmacy will send the bill for your prescription to Express Scripts. This is a pharmacy benefits management organization with whom SFM partners.

### You've already gotten a prescription filled, and you paid for it

Send the receipt and a copy of the prescription to your SFM claims representative for reimbursement.

### You'd like to have refills mailed to you

If you will be on a medication for a long time, you can choose to get refills through the mail. Call Express Scripts toll-free at (877) 568-5522.

### You lost your prescription identification card

If you've already used your card to get a prescription and now you're going back to the same pharmacy to get a refill, you don't need another ID card. If you do need a new card, call your SFM claims representative.
