WHEREAS: The SFM Foundation, also known as Kids' Chance of Minnesota, has awarded scholarships to over

200 kids totaling over \$3.2 million since its inception in 2008; and

WHEREAS: The SFM Foundation is one of many Kids' Chance organizations throughout the United States

that make a significant difference in the lives of children affected by a workplace injury, though,

there are likely more students in need of assistance; and

WHEREAS: November 7-11, 2022, has been designated Kids' Chance Awareness Week to increase the visibility

of Kids' Chance organizations across the country and to spread the word about Kids' Chance

scholarship opportunities.
